IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING RESIDENTIAL PARKING DAILY PERMITS

Starting March 1, there will be some changes to the City of Chicago Residential Zone Parking Program.

These improvements are part of an ongoing effort to make the Residential Zone Parking Program as efficient and fair as possible.

Please note the following

- 1. Credit card and check are the ONLY forms of payment accepted for the purchase of Residential Parking Daily Permits at ward offices.**
- 2. Customers can now buy THREE sheets of permits per 30 day period instead of just two.**
- 3. New residents must provide proof of residency via email to EZBUY@cityofchicago.org to purchase permits at ward offices.***

All products are still available at City Clerk sales locations and there is no price change - each sheet of 15 daily permits is \$8.00.

The following documents can be used to establish residency:

- A valid Driver's License, State ID or government-issued ID showing a home address within the residential zone;
OR a valid government-issued ID AND any of the following documents that include the correct address within the residential zone:
- A current mortgage or lease;
- A bill for any of the following utilities or services:
 - Property tax;
 - Water, gas or electric;
 - Landline phone;
 - Satellite or cable television;
- USPS Change of Address Confirmation

*Ward staff may be able to help you send the required documents. This process may take more than one business day, especially during evening hours or weekends.
