#### **Key Construction Updates**

- The north side of the hospital is closed for construction including the sidewalk and four parking spaces on the south side of Barry Ave.
  - The hospital has provided four parking spaces in the parking lot adjacent to the L tracks during the parking restriction on Barry Ave.
- Concrete foundations are complete and the tower crane has been deployed to support installation of structural steel framing.
- Alert: Structural steel and concrete floor installation will continue through March of 2024 and may produce minor noise/ vibration from delivery truck access to the construction site between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Flow of vehicular traffic on Barry Ave will not be impeded for these activities.

### **Key Construction Updates Cont.**

• The hospital's Center for Advanced Care (CAC) entrance is closed for construction, please use the main hospital entrance at 836 W. Wellington Ave.

This is accessible from Wellington Ave. while the CAC entrance is closed.

- Building occupancy and first patient for the west and vertical expansion is scheduled for the third quarter of 2025 with final completion of the expansion in Fall of 2026.
