#### **Key Construction Updates**

- The green space on the north side of the hospital along Barry Ave. is closed for construction including the sidewalk on the south side of Barry Ave. Demolition of the west building façade is complete.
- Installation of concrete foundations and footings is underway and will continue into August.
- A tower crane will be deployed in August to support structural steel framing installation.
- ALERT: These activities may produce minor noise/vibration from excavation equipment and truck traffic between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. Monday through Saturday.
  - Traffic on Barry Ave. will not be impeded for these activities. We have permitted with the city to close three parking spaces on the south side of Barry Ave through the end of the year to support the structural steel activities.

## **Key Construction Updates Cont.**

- The hospital's Center for Advanced Care (CAC)
  entrance is closed for construction, please use the main
  hospital entrance at 836 W. Wellington Ave.
  - This is accessible from Wellington Ave. while the CAC entrance is closed.
- Building occupancy and first patient for the west and vertical expansion is scheduled for the first quarter 2025 with final completion of the expansion in summer of 2026.
