Work Activity: Alley Reconstruction

**Local Impact:** 

- The alley east of 959 962 W. Belmont Avenue & 3211 3247 N. Sheffield Avenue will be closed until the work activity is complete.
- For your safety, please do not attempt to use the alley for any purpose unless in an emergency situation.
- Contractor will provide alternative parking for residents with dedicated private parking
  accessed via the alleyway. If you need further information about alternative parking,

- Garbage and recycling bins for 959 962 W. Belmont Avenue & 3211 3247 N.
   Sheffield Avenue will be relocated to N. Sheffield Avenue. Please dispose of garbage and recycling in your relocated bins on N. Sheffield Avenue until the alley is reopened and the contactor has moved the bins back.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
  - General construction noise
  - Loud noise from pavement demolition
  - o Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
