Work Activity: Flyover Drip Pan Installation Preparation

Local Impact:

- Crews will be working in the alley preparing the structure for future drip pan installation under the Brown Line Flyover.
- Access to the alley and garages/parking spaces behind 1015 1041 W. Newport Avenue & 1014 – 1044 W. Roscoe Street will be maintained with delays during work hours for crews to move.
- The north/south alley just east of N. Seminary Avenue will not be impacted.
- There will be additional impacts to the alley and garages/parking spaces. Advance notification will be provided.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - o General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
