We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

RESTRICTED STREET ACCESS

Dates: Friday, October 17 to Monday, October 20, 2025
Friday, October 24 to Monday, October 27, 2025

Location: W. Waveland Avenue & W. Grace Street between N. Sheffield Avenue & N. Wilton Avenue

Work Hours: W. Waveland Avenue - 7am-Friday until 5am-Monday; around-the-clock work
W. Grace Street – 7am-Friday until 5pm-Monday; around-the-clock work

Work Activity: Crane Staging & Trackwork – Weekend #3 Northbound Purple Line & Weekend #4 Northbound Redline

Local Impact:

- Flaggers will assist with local traffic on W. Waveland Avenue & W. Grace Street and local access to adjacent alleys.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Waveland Avenue within the work zone will be closed until the work activity is complete. The sidewalk on the south side of the street will remain open at all times.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Grace Street will be closed as necessary. The sidewalk on the north side of the street will remain open at all times.
- Access to the alleys east of N. Sheffield Avenue north and south of W. Waveland Avenue will be maintained via W. Grace Street & N. Sheffield Avenue, respectively, with flagger assistance when necessary.
- Access to the parking lot for 954 W. Grace Street will be maintained.
- Businesses will remain accessible at all times.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, **including overnight noise.**
 - General construction noise
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools, air compressors and generators
 - Loud noise from jack hammers, chain saws and drilling
 - Beeping for backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
